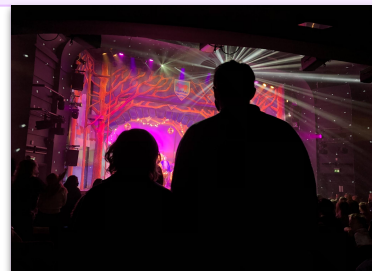


# Weekly Information Bulletin
