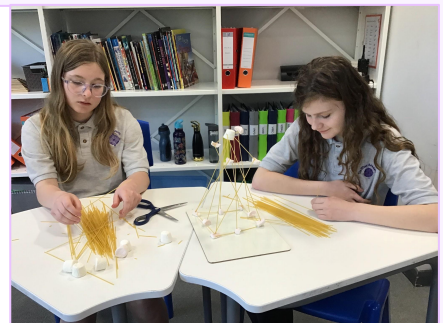
Duke of Edinburgh Trip
