Monet class have been working really hard this week on developing their communication skills through teamwork challenges. We really enjoyed the Cup Tower Challenge! This is how you do it - it may be something you want to try at home! This is a great activity for practising speaking and listening skills, developing team work and patience and learning how to problem solve, all of which are essential skills for independent living at home, at school and in the wider world!

- 1. Set up the cups in a stack or in a line.
- 2. Tie the three pieces of string to the elastic band so that each player can hold one string.
- 3. The goal is to move and stack the cups into a tower, but you can only use the string and elastic band—no hands touching the cups!
- 4. Work as a team to stretch and loosen the elastic band around each cup to pick it up and place it in the right spot.
- 5. Keep going until you build a tower
