- In order for us to secure the funding for this event we are required to send some student information so we are able to secure this funding. This will include student names and date of births. Please contact reception if you need any further information.

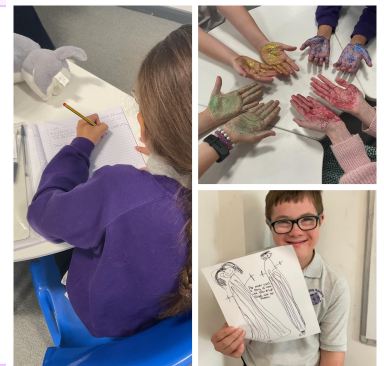
