Haring class had a very exciting week launching their sharing event all about chocolate called 'From Bean to Bar!' We had visitors from the Oxford Botanic Gardens, Pitt Rivers and Ashmolean Museum, the Museum of Oxford and the History of Science Museum. The class shared what they have learned this term about where certain food items come from with a focus on the life cycle of a cocoa plant. Our activities included - chocolate tasting (a firm favourite), describing the life cycle of a cocoa pod, which plants produce certain food items, a unique PACMAN chocolate bar design and information about Fair Trade. All of the students were fantastically engaged and enthusiastic, and hopefully really enjoyed the finale of our project this term.
