Family Fun Day - Saturday 27th June 2026

Our Family Fun Day is fast approaching and will take place on Saturday 27th June from 11.00 - 2.00.

This will be a ticket only event. Tickets will be sent home via students on Monday. Please contact reception if you do not receive your tickets.

Please find some further information below in preparation for the event:

- There has been a recent change in parking restrictions in Iffley and some roads that surround the school are now double yellow lines. There will be limited parking available at school so please travel via public transport if possible.
- Please be considerate of our neighbours when arriving and leaving and please do not block access if parking in the surrounding area.
- Dogs and smoking/vaping are not permitted on school site.
- Children must be supervised by a parent/carer throughout the fun day.
- Please be aware that photos will be taken during the event.
- Last year's event was extremely popular, to avoid disappointment we advise arriving at the beginning of the event.
- Tickets will be sent home to parents/carers closer to the event.
- We will be running an introduction to forest school sessions on the day including the option to toast marshmallows, if you are planning on attending one of these sessions in the Forest School please wear enclosed shoes as no flip flops or sandals will be permitted. Please be aware due to the activities we have available, the site and mixture of groups we are unable to have children 5 years old or younger access this activity in the Forest School.
- To support families building networks with other families across the school, this year at the family fun day there will be an informal opportunity to meet other parents/carers from your child's class. If you wish at 12.00 you're invited to stand by the class name of your child to meet other parents/carers - these signs will be visible on the day or ask a staff member for directions.

On Tuesday 14th July we will be holding an information evening where parents and carers will have the opportunity to meet with class teachers.

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National changes to Free School Meals (FSM) - action required

We are writing to share some news regarding national changes to the Free School Meal (FSM) program that will take effect from September 2026.

From the start of the 2026 to 2027 academic year, all children from households in receipt of Universal Credit will be entitled to receive a free meal.

Going forward there will be 2 categories of benefits based free school meals:

- Targeted FSM, which continues to be based on the existing threshold, covering pupils who are in households in receipt of Universal Credit with annual household earnings of £7,400 or less
- Expanded FSM, a new category covering pupils who do not qualify for targeted FSM, but who are in households receiving Universal Credit

So we can ensure all pupils who are eligible are registered and receive their free school meal, the government requires us to run new eligibility checks for the 2026/27 school year. Previous transitional protections will finish in July this year, all families whose children are currently eligible must be rechecked.

We are asking all parents/carers who receive Universal Credit or if you think they may now qualify under the new rules to complete the google form below:

You only need to complete this form once. Subsequent rechecks of your eligibility will be carried out annually to assess whether you continue to be eligible for free school meals. You should contact the school or local authority if you have a change in financial circumstances.

So we can be ready for the next academic year please complete this form as soon as possible.
