Students will be bringing home a letter today detailing their class teacher for September 2022. This information will be shared with students this afternoon.

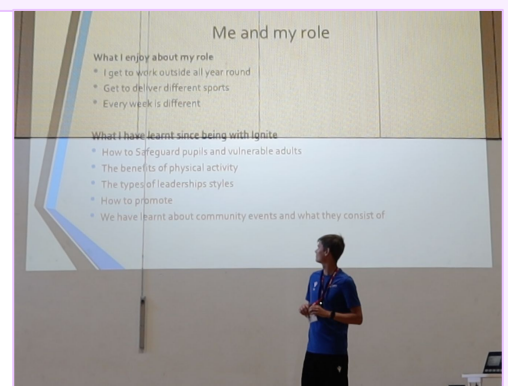
