Dear Parents/ Carers,

Welcome back to Northern House Academy for the final term of the academic year! We hope you had a wonderful half term. As we enter the final term of the year, we're excited for all the fantastic learning opportunities ahead.

This term, our English lessons will focus on creative writing. The children will have the exciting challenge of studying multiple different Greek myths and Legends and using their imagination and creativity to retell, write their own and study a variety of different punctuation and grammar features to add increased detail and techniques to their writing

In Maths, we will be exploring length, fractions, and place value, helping the children develop their understanding of these key concepts in a fun and engaging way.

Our Science lessons will take us back to the world of plants as well as giving the children the opportunity to enjoy a variety of different scientific experiments to test the children's investigation skills.

In PSHE, we will be focusing on the theme of growing and changing, where children will be looking at positive relationships along with first aid and studying the importance of personal space. Computing lessons will continue to develop the children's knowledge of e-safety.

In art the children will be studying and developing their own greek patterns alongside making our own Greek inspired vases with the children's pottery skills. In Geography, we will be looking at the Greek islands and how they differ from the UK both in human and physical geographical terms
