## Meet the Colleges Sept 2024

On Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> Sept 2024, the Oak Lodge held a 'Meet the Colleges' evening for all year 14 students and their parents. Both Activate Learning and Abingdon & Witney College presented a short presentation explaining their provision in detail. The event was attended by six of the nine students and families leaving Oak Lodge this academic year. For those parents that were unable to attend the event, it was recorded and sent out to them the following day. The event was incredibly well received by all parents who fed back the below.



- Prior to the evening 66% of parents were not aware of which college they want their child to transition onto.
- Before the event, 83% of parents did not know how to apply and 'name' their child's chosen college.
- 100% of parents stated that they found the evening extremely informative.
- 83% of parents spoke to the colleges on an individual basis, following the presentation.
- 100% of parents said that following the event they now have a better understanding of where they would like their child to transition onto.
- 100% of parents stated that following the event, they now have a better understanding of the application process and how to 'name' their child's chosen college.
- 83% of parents said there was no additional information which they would have liked to have learnt. The one parent who did, said they would like more information on how to apply for transport.
- When asked, have you found the event beneficial and if so, how, parents stated:
  - o I was able to speak to the representative from different colleges in person.
  - o I now understand the process of translon.
  - Reassuring
  - So much for me to consider and plan. A very good start for me. It took away most of my worries.
  - Absolutely, very useful.
  - o The presenters from each college have given us a great view about each college.
